When modifying a config value that requires an array, the foreman_config_entry type is not idempotent.	
Example:	
<pre>foreman_config_entry {'trusted_puppetmaster_hosts':   value =&gt; ["\puppet1.example.com\", \"puppet2.example.com\"], }</pre>	
returns on the second run:	
<pre>value changed '"\puppet1.example.com\", \"puppet2.example.com\""' to '["puppet1.example.com", " puppet2.example.com"]'</pre>
