Description		
<p>Both Dynflow with Sidekiq and Pulp 3 will use Redis. Currently EPEL contains Redis 3.2. There is also a Redis 5 SCL which has the benefit of providing a newer version. It also has a clearer life cycle and users of RHEL have the benefit of commercial support.</p> <p>For reference, Debian 10 ships Redis 5.0 and Ubuntu 18.04 ships 4.0. The newer version will reduce the number of different versions in use.</p> <p>voxpupuli-redis 5.0.0 adds support for using the SCL version. This can be enabled by setting <code>redis::globals::scl</code> via Hiera.</p>
