<b>Description</b>		
There is a parameter on foreman_proxy_content to set Apache's SSLProtocol on vhosts. However, it's possible to set this Apache wide. As we're moving to TLS 1.2+ by default ( <a href="#">#31386</a> ), this only makes it easy to avoid this. It will remain possible to set individual services via Hiera.
