Fixes #31834 - Use PostgreSQL 12 on EL8

This aligns Red Hat 7 and Red Hat 8 on PostgreSQL 12. It uses the a specific git commit for DNF module support but without dropping Puppet 5 to allow for a cherry pick to 2.4. After develop drops Puppet 5 support, it should switch to $\geq 7.0.1$ as a version specifier.

It may break existing installations on PostgreSQL 10 since there is no upgrade path. Those users are recommended to set version to 10 in their custom-hiera.yaml or upgrade to PostgreSQL 12.
