<div>Description</div> <div>The installer can deploy a cronjob to clean up old tasks from the database. This is enabled by default in the Satellite scenario, but not for Foreman and Katello. We should change that.</div> <div>Changing the default for new installations is easy.</div> <div>Changing the default on upgrade requires a migration a la:</div> <div><pre>if !answers['foreman::plugin::tasks'].is_a?(Hash)   answers['foreman::plugin::tasks']['automatic_cleanup'] = true   answers['foreman::plugin::tasks']['cron_line'] = "45 19 * * *" end</pre></div> <div>This should be clearly documented in the release notes, so users can pass --foreman-plugin-tasks-automatic-cleanup false during upgrade, to avoid having the cronjob active.</div>
