<p>The installer can deploy a cronjob to clean up old tasks from the database. This is enabled by default in the Satellite scenario, but not for Foreman and Katello. We should change that.</p> <p>Changing the default for new installations is easy.</p> <p>Changing the default on upgrade requires a migration a la:</p> <pre>if !answers['foreman::plugin::tasks'].is_a?(Hash) answers['foreman::plugin::tasks']['automatic_cleanup'] = true answers['foreman::plugin::tasks']['cron_line'] = "45 19 * * *" end</pre> <p>This should be clearly documented in the release notes, so users can pass --foreman-plugin-tasks-automatic-cleanup false during upgrade, to avoid having the cronjob active.</p>
