With this PR (<u>https://github.com/theforeman/puppet-pulpcore/pull/267</u>), Pulpcore Telemetry is likely going to be marked as opt-in with enabling being possible with custom hiera. It's very unlikely that anyone will ever turn it on, however. Due to that, I think we should move to an opt-out model and make it obvious how to avoid sending the telemetry.
