Rather than requiring the user to specify it twice, this prefers the Hiera answer from the foreman_proxy module with the older value as a fallback. It's also a default, so users providing it explicitly won't be affected.

This default matches what's in theforeman/puppetserver_foreman and is not needed. Users can still override it, but the default just duplicates things.

theforeman/puppetserver_foreman has started to default to copying the value from foreman_proxy::foreman_base_url when unspecified. theforeman/puppet has removed its default. This completes it by removing the value if both answers are the same.

The biggest benefit is that the user only needs to care about a single answer and no longer keep them in sync. This means we can stop thinking about whether Puppet is enabled or not in all our user instructions.
